ADJUSTMENTS TO M/V BELLA DESGAGNÉS' ITINERARY FOR THE CURRENT VOYAGE

Rimouski, December 21, 2017 — Relais Nordik, operator of the coastal supply ship service for the Anticosti Island and the Lower North Shore, announced that due to extreme wind conditions, the M/V Bella Desgagnés was unable to go to Port-Menier. Considering that the weather conditions will not improve before Friday afternoon, the Company has decided to pursue its downstream route. Consequently, **the boarding hours for the next ports of the downstream route have changed**. We are asking scheduled Kegaska boarding clients to arrive tonight at the dock for 10 pm.

Also, taking into consideration that we are close to Christmas, an alternative service will exceptionally be put in place to transport by air, the essential goods of this voyage destined to Port-Menier, Anticosti Island.
