M/V BELLA DESGAGNÉS' ITINERARY TO RETURN TO REGULAR SCHEDULE

Rimouski, July 10, 2019 — Relais Nordik, operator of the coastal supply ship service for Anticosti Island and the Lower North Shore, announced today that changes made to the itinerary last week in order to catch up on accumulated delay, have reduced the gap from being 18 to 8 hours late and that, in order to return to the schedule, the M/V *Bella Desgagnés* will not be going to St-Augustin on his upstream journey of the current voyage.

Given the planned presence of cruise ships in Havre-Saint-Pierre next week, it is very important to be on schedule to avoid any conflict at the Havre-Saint-Pierre wharf that would cause further delays.
