DIFFICULT NAVIGATION CONDITIONS FOR THE M/V BELLA DESGAGNÉS

Rimouski, September 4, 2019 — Relais Nordik, operator of the maritime service of the Anticosti Island and the Lower North Shore, announced that the weather forecast in the Gulf of St. Lawrence will make navigation difficult. As such, M/V *Bella Desgagnés* will leave Kegaska earlier than scheduled today. Customers are asked to be at the wharf before the estimated time of arrival of the vessel at 5 pm.

M/V *Bella Desgagnés* will continue her journey eastward, assessing the possibility of safely landing at each of the planned stops. Given that the arrival and departure of the ship in some ports could be earlier than scheduled, the Company asks its customers to follow the progress of the *Bella Desgagnés* by consulting the website at <http://position.desgagnes.com/rni.asp> which will be updated regularly, and to present itself at the wharf before the expected arrival of the ship in order to be able to proceed with the boarding quickly. It also invites all users to contact their local agent for the expected arrival and departure times in their port.
