**RELAIS NORDIK ANNOUNCES THE OPENING OF THE NATASHQUAN AGENCY AND THE NEW
SCHEDULE ADJUSTED TO RESPECT SPEED RESTRICTIONS IN THE
WHALE PROTECTION AREAS**

Rimouski, May 14, 2020 — The company Relais Nordik, operator of the maritime service to Anticosti Island and the Lower North Shore, wishes to share the service schedule and inform its users that, as of the voyage starting on May 18th, the Natashquan community will again be served by the M / V *Bella Desgagnés*.

Natashquan's agency will be open as of Monday, May 18th for deliveries of goods on the terms announced earlier this week.

Relais Nordik reminds all of its customers that they must follow the rules of social distancing in agencies and requests that they inform themselves about changes in practice in connection with COVID-19. Please note that reservations for the transportation of vehicles are mandatory and deliveries and handing over of vehicles are made according to a specific schedule. Passenger transportation service has been suspended until further notice.

Important note

The M/V Bella Desgagnés' primary mission is to transport cargo to local communities and provide them with a safe and reliable means of transportation every week. The voyage is not a traditional cruise.

The duration of port calls is therefore determined based on the time needed to load and unload cargo. The time may also be increased or decreased if, for diverse operational reasons, the ship must make up for a delay or adjust its schedule due to unfavorable sailing conditions.

Given the constraints of sailing conditions the timetable is in no way guaranteed. If you have made arrangements to use the services of another public carrier (plane, ferry, motor-coach or rail services) to return home at the end of your sea voyage, we recommend that you give yourself a 36 to 48 hour window between disembarking from the vessel and your embarkation with the subsequent carrier.
