PERISHABLE GOODS WILL BE TRANSPORTED TO VILLAGES

Rimouski, December 17, 2020 — Relais Nordik, operator of the maritime service to Anticosti Island and the Lower North Shore, wishes to inform its users that, in collaboration with the Société des Traversiers du Québec, all perishable goods received in Rimouski, Sept-Îles and Havre-St-Pierre that are currently onboard the *Bella Desgagnés* will be transported by plane or truck to their destination in the coming days.

The Company asks customers to check, starting tomorrow (Friday) noon, with their local agent, the reception schedule for their goods at the airport or at the port in the case of Blanc-Sablon.

The perishable goods that we currently receive at our warehouses will be transported as planned when the ship leaves Sept-Îles.

Goods other than perishable goods will remain on board the ship and will be transported as soon as the *Bella Desgagnés* can leave Sept-Îles. Being already loaded to full capacity, non-perishable goods received at our warehouses will be loaded on the following voyage.

At the moment we don't have more details on the repair time of the M/V *Bella Desgagnés*, but she should be back in service next week.

The entire Relais Nordik team is actively working to resolve this situation as quickly as possible and thanks their customers for their understanding.
