**THE M/V NORDIK EXPRESS RESUMES SERVICE FOR THE PROVISIONNING OF
ANTICOSTI ISLAND AND THE LOWER NORTH SHORE**

Rimouski, January 4, 2021 — Relais Nordik, operator of the maritime service of Anticosti Island and the Lower North Shore, announced that it has received all the necessary clearances to put the *M/V Nordik Express* back into service.

The team has been working for several days on the return to service of the vessel *N/V Nordik Express*, which has not sailed for a few years. The ship's departure date from the port of Quebec will be announced as soon as possible, depending on the preparation work currently underway.

The *Bella Desgagnés* docked at the port of Sept-Îles this morning after delivering the cargo from the last voyage and the ship is scheduled to leave Sept-Îles at the end of the evening tomorrow, January 5, with all cargo received as of January 4. The route will be determined upon departure, taking into account the weather forecast and the presence of ice in the ports.

The *M/V Nordik Express* will be used as soon as possible to deliver goods, in order to complete the regular season trips.
